


OIL REFINING CAPACITY IN AUSTRALIA

Australia should be an energy superpower

- Not enough refining capacity.
- Refining capacity has been cut by two-thirds to just under 25% of its total needs since 2010.
- On a per capita basis, Australia now has 84% less domestic refining capacity than the US



The best coal – the worst decisions

Coal Exports by Country

Below are the 15 countries that exported the highest dollar value worth of coal during 2022.

1. Australia: US\$83.3 billion (35% of total coal exports)

- 2. Indonesia: \$46.7 billion (19.6%)
- 3. Russia: \$42.8 billion (18%)
- 4. United States: \$17.3 billion (7.3%)
- 5. South Africa: \$13 billion (5.5%)
- 6. Canada: \$10.8 billion (4.5%)
- 7. Mongolia: \$6.5 billion (2.7%)
- 8. Netherlands: \$2.2 billion (0.9%)
- 9. Mozambique: \$2 billion (0.9%)
- 10. Poland: \$1.6 billion (0.7%)
- 11. Colombia: \$1.3 billion (0.6%)
- 12. China: \$1.2 billion (0.5%)


